Organizational Development and Leadership Training Program Launch

We've launched an **organizational development and leadership training program** for a mission-driven organization in Recife, Brazil, working to combat sex trafficking, abuse, and poverty. This initiative is part of a larger strategy aimed at strengthening leadership and team operational performance within the organization. We will work with their team throughout the year, equipping **23 department leaders** with the tools they need to thrive and lead with impact in their communities.

Value Creation for Wealth Building

We kicked off our Financial Empowerment Workshop series in March with an amazing session led by Doug Hamilton! Doug, his wife Michelle, and their four children traveled to from the U.S. to Brazil for this event and it did not disappoint. Hosted at the Arte Suave DreamRoot Training Center, **44 community members** attended.

The session focused on how developing our skills and abilities can create meaningful impact—not just for others, but also for our own financial growth. Beyond financial education, we explored the concept of **value creation**, **unlocking vision**, and **inspiring hope** for dreams that once felt out of reach. The action plan steps and Q&A were particularly impactful.

This session emphasized understanding finances from a wealth-creation perspective, teaching community members how to make strategic moves today for long-term success. Doug shared valuable insights and tools to help individuals recognize and **grow their current resources, invest in themselves, and create lasting value**. Financial empowerment starts with the right mindset and practical steps.



In addition to learning, the evening concluded with staying for **jiu-jitsu class** and moments of **connection** and discussion over a **shared meal**, where participants dreamed together for what is possible.

Empowering Neurodivergent Learners

Inclusion: Impact of the Community Capacity-Building Workshop

The impact of the community capacity-building workshop focused on strategies for teaching neurodivergent children, held in October at the Arte Suave DreamRoot Training Center, has been extraordinary. The event provided trainers, coaches, parents, and community members with practical skills to support and learn from autistic children and those with diverse learning needs.

Since the workshop, the Arte Suave jiu jitsu program has **expanded to include 22 additional neurodivergent children.**



Juliana, a coach at the center who attended the workshop, used it as a "train the trainer" opportunity. She has since approached a local private school, offering to apply what she has learned and is now **supporting four neurodivergent children in their learning** through jiu jitsu and they are already showing academic improvement. Thanks to DreamRoot's Gi Drive, these children now have their own uniforms, removing barriers and allowing them to fully participate.

These children aren't just learning new skills—they're learning how to learn, and improving their ability to learn more effectively and setting them up for a lifetime of success.

Sports can enhance children's learning by improving cognitive skills, focus, and social interaction, and for children with autism, they provide structured opportunities to develop essential life skills.



HAITI REGIONAL SCHOOL COLLABORATION

Sports Clinics

Rose and David, local leaders from Haiti DreamRoot, have **launched a regional collaboration** with other schools to host sports clinics. Their school sent **20 students** to participate in basketball, volleyball, and tennis clinics. This partnership is helping build connections among local leaders, while giving students opportunities to stay active, learn new skills, and find joy despite challenging circumstances. Programs like this help develop teamwork, leadership, and discipline by providing children with structured opportunities to learn new skills, build self-confidence, and foster positive relationships, which contribute to personal growth and community development.



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HAITI TUTORING PROGRAM

Our tutoring sessions in Haiti are making incredible progress! With **120 students and 9 dedicated tutors**, the program has greatly **boosted** the students' **academic performance**.

Thanks to the commitment of local leaders Rose and David, this initiative continues to inspire and empower the community. The success of the tutoring program has allowed the school to grow and increase its student enrollment, providing more opportunities for local children to succeed.



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
